#### **LENT 2025**

Lent is here with us once again! We are invited to journey through this season to the most important Christian Festival of the Year - HOLY WEEK AND EASTER.

Lent is not just about giving something up; it is also about doing something extra. Whatever we decide to do, this should help us 'to die a little more to self'. It is a Season of **Prayer**, and prayer acquires strength when accompanied by **Fasting** and **Almsgiving**. During Lent we have our eyes firmly fixed on Jesus and His journey to Jerusalem and we journey with Him. Lent is about growing in love for God, for one another and for those most in need.

### ASH WEDNESDAY: 5th March

Today is kept as a day of **Fasting** and **Abstinence.** It is a day we should make every effort to join with our Parish Community at Mass and so get Lent off to a good start. At Mass we will be signed with the ashes - the traditional sign reminding us that this is a season of **Repentance** and **Renewal.** We are called to "Repent and believe in the Gospel".
